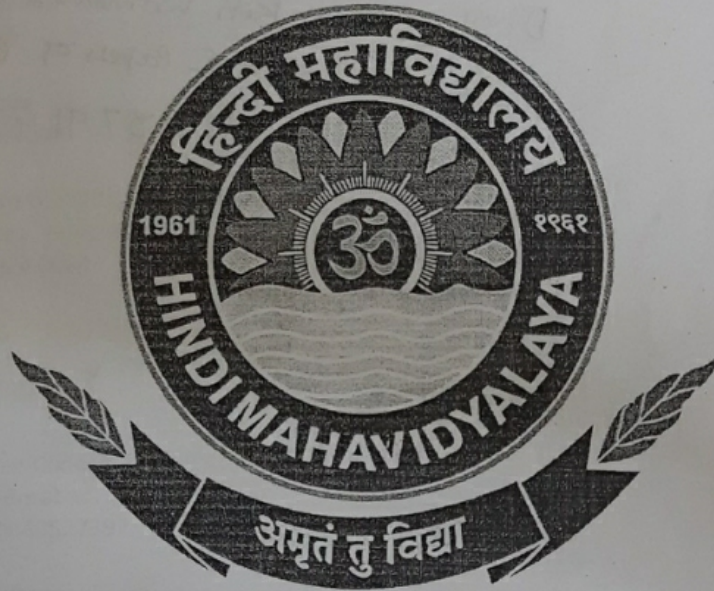

3 Introduction of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

It was informed to the respective chairperson and members that from the academic year 2016-17 Osmania University has introduced all the degree colleges including Autonomous Degree College to follow CBCS under which after passing the exam student will get the Grade in the Final Result. In this continuation department is introducing the same system for BA III year.

#### Discussion on Pattern of Semester exam and Model Question paper

- IV. Pattern of model question papers of both the semester is enclosed.

#### 6. Marks allotted for Internal and end Semester exams.

- I. Internal assessment is of 20 marks.
