The chair welcomed the University Nominee, Chairperson BOS, O.U Department of Political Science and Members of B.O.S.

Meeting details.

Dr. Surabhi Tiwari informed the respective chairperson and members that from the academic Year 2012-13 Hindi Mahavidyalaya is following Semester system and we have completed 7 years of Autonomy. In the year 2018-19 college received autonomy again for 6 years. Last Meeting was held in the academic year 2018-19 on 16 July 2018.

Details of choice based credit system.

From the Academic Year 2016-17 Osmania University has instructed all the Degree colleges including Autonomous Degree colleges to follow CBCS under which after passing the exam student will get the Grade in the Final Result. Credits are given for theory paper.

Discussion and Distribution of Common Core Syllabus.

- i. Members were informed by the chair that Department of Political Science, Hindi Mahavidyalaya is following common core syllabus prescribed by TSCH (Telangana State Council of Higher Education).
- ii. We are following same Syllabus prescribed by Osmania University of each Semester with few changes.
- iii. Department has distributed B.A I Year Syllabus in two parts i.e Semester I and Semester II

Discussion on Pattern of Semester exam

- I. It was informed by the department that in each Semester Two Internal exams will be conducted.
- II. Semester exams will be conducted as per the Almanac which will be provided by the exam branch. Internal exam duration will be 15 Min and Semester exam duration will be of 2 ½ hrs.
- III. On line Internal Exam- From the Academic year 2019-20 Institution is following on line Exam for Internal Assessments. Department of Political Science is following the instructions.

Discussion on Pattern of Model Question paper

Model Question paper for Semester I and Semester II was discussed. Theory paper for each Semester will have 2 sections.

- i. Section A contains 10 short type questions. Any 5 questions should be attempted. Each Question carries 4 marks (5 4m = 20m).
- ii. Section B contains 5 essay type questions with internal choice. Each Question carries 10marks (5 x 10=50).

Item of Model Question Papers for Paper I and Paper II are enclosed.

Item of Semester Exam and Model Question Paper was approved by all the committee members.

Marks allotted for Internal and end Semester exams.

1. Internal assessment is of 30 marks. In each Semester two internal assessment of 15 marks each will be conducted and an average of both the internal assessments will be considered. 5 Marks assignment is given and added to the total internal Assessment Marks
 2. Theory Question paper is of 70 marks.
 3. Total allotted marks are 100.
