**2.2 Previous meeting details.**

Mrs. Priyanka Sharma informed the respective members regarding the previous meeting which was held on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 and 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2017. **2.3 Details of choice based credit system.**

- ii. Section B contains 10 essay type questions with internal choice. Each Question carries 10 marks (5 x 10 = 50).

## 2.7 Marks allotted for Internal and end Semester exams.
