

8.1 Welcome address by the chair

The chair welcomed the University Nominee and O.U Department of History and Members of B.O.S.

8.2 Previous meeting details.

Mrs. Archana Singh informed the respective members regarding the previous meeting which was held on 2nd August 2017 and 6th January 2020. She informed that from the academic year 2012-13 onwards Hindi Mahavidyalaya was granted Autonomous status for the period of 8 years. College has implemented CBCS semester system as required under Autonomy for the last 6 years.

8.3 Details of choice based credit system.

From the Academic Year 2016-17 Osmania University has instructed all the Degree colleges including Autonomous Degree colleges to follow CBCS under which after passing the exam student will get the Grade in the Final Result. 5 Credits are given for each Disciplines Specified Course.

8.4 Discussion and Distribution of Common Core Syllabus and Skill Enhancement Course.

- i. Members were informed by the chair that Department of History, Hindi Mahavidyalaya is following common core syllabus and Skill Enhancement Course prescribed by Osmania University, Hyderabad.

Department has distributed B.A II Year Syllabus i.e Semester III "History of India (1526-1857 CE) and Semester IV History of India (1858-1964 CE)". The SEC course prescribed by the department "Historical and Cultural Tourism in India" in Semester III and "Archives and Museums" in Semester IV.

Common Core Syllabus and SEC were unanimously accepted by all the committee members.

8.5 Discussion on Pattern of Semester exam

1. It was informed by the department that in each Semester Two Internal exams will be conducted and an average of both the internal assessments will be added in the marks of theory exam.
2. Semester exam will be conducted as per the Almanac which will be provided by the exam branch. Internal exam duration will be 25 Minutes and Semester exam duration will be of 2 ½ hrs.
3. Only One Internal assessment will be conducted for SEC.

8.6 Discussion on Pattern and Model Paper of Semester exam and Model Paper of Internal Exam

1. It was informed by the department that in each Semester Two Internal exams will be conducted for 20 marks.

Section – A: 20 multiple choice questions each carries 1 mark (20x1=20M)

Average of marks of these two internal exams will be taken. 5 marks will be allotted for assignment and 5 marks for seminar.

2. Model Question paper for Semester III and Semester IV was discussed. Theory paper for each Semester will have 2 sections.

- i) **Section A** contains 4 short Questions. The student has to answer five questions.

Each question carries 4 Marks (5X4=20 Marks)

- ii) **Section B** contains 5 Essay type Questions with internal choice.

Each Question carries 10 Marks (5X10=50 Marks)

3. Model Question paper for SEC Semester III and Semester IV was discussed. Theory paper for each SEC Semester will have 2 sections.

- i) **Section A** contains 6 short Questions. The student has to answer three questions.

Each question carries 5 Marks (3X5=15 Marks)

- ii) **Section B** contains 2 Essay type Questions with internal choice.

Each Question carries 10 Marks (2X10=20 Marks)
